

STUDENT ATHLETE POST-SECONDARY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Alberta Female Hockey League will annually present up to 10 scholarships, valuing in \$1,000 each. These scholarships will be awarded to the student athletes who best exemplify the values of the AFHL; academics, athletics, and personal growth. These scholarships will be awarded to players who have plans of attending post-secondary during the 2026-27 academic year. Student-Athletes applying for these scholarships do not necessarily need to be seeking to play hockey at that post-secondary institution.

- Scholarships are available to any graduating U18 AA/AAA player within the AFHL continuing on to post-secondary. Applicants must be enrolling in full-time studies at a recognized post secondary institution.
- Criteria
 - Fall into the aforementioned age range (specified above)
 - In good academic standing with current academic institution
 - Leader within their team and the sport of hockey
 - Contributes positively to their school or community
 - Demonstrates the values of the AFHL
 - Must be attending full-time post-secondary for the 2026-27 season (does not need to be playing on a hockey team)
- Applications MUST include:
 - Athlete photo for promotional use if the applicant is successful
 - Personal Information Questionnaire
 - Personal Resume; it should include academic standing, athletic achievements, leadership activities, community service, other extra-curricular activities (sports, clubs, etc), academic awards and work experience (if any).
 - Copy of highschool transcripts (unofficial transcripts are accepted however applicants must be able to provide official transcripts prior to Sept 1 if requested)
 - Personal Essay (300- 500 words)
 - Letter of recommendation from current head coach
 - Letter of recommendation from school administrator or teacher
- How Selections will be made:
 - The Elite Female Hockey Committee will select the successful applicants; based on high academic achievement, strong contributor to female hockey, contributions to their community and upstanding individual character.
 - The successful candidate will be notified on or before May 15 and announced publicly shortly thereafter
 - **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
